

KISS Health and Safety Guidelines

- 1 Springfield Baptist Church asks that the room is sanitized after use by spraying bleach water (provided) and using sanitizing wipes. We are all responsible to see that this happens every time we use the room. Don't forget to wipe off the door handles for both doors and the bathroom door. Spray the bathroom with the bleach spray.
- 2 When ever the weather allows, KISS will meet outdoors at the Springfield Baptist Church under the tree in front of our room. Chairs brought outside for the meeting need to be sanitized when they are returned to the room.
- 3 The meeting format is in a plastic protector and should be sanitized before putting it away. The 7th tradition basket will be placed in the middle of the circle and people will drop their donation in; do not pass the basket from person to person.
- 4 If someone wants to purchase a book, they should just tell someone they are buying a book and put the money in the 7th tradition basket. Only the treasurer should handle the basket.
- 5 Social distancing is important and should be kept in mind in placing chairs for the meeting. The chairs will be placed 6 feet apart. The outdoor seating will also maintain 6 feet apart.
- 6 Our mask policy depends on whether the meeting is indoors or outdoors. Outdoors, masks are completely optional; many people do not wear masks outside. Indoors, masks are encouraged, but not required. Those not wearing a mask will sit on the left side of the room; those wearing masks will sit on the right side.
- 7 If you are ill or have been exposed to Covid19, please do not attend the meeting.
- 8 Hand sanitizer and wipes are not provided. It is recommended that you have your own with you.
- 9 We do not hold hands for the closing circle. We stand and stretch our hands out towards the person on either side, do not touch hands. Some people like to wiggle their fingers 😊.
- 10 Most importantly, we encourage people to be responsible for themselves and to explain our policies gently but firmly to anyone who is new to the group.
